Brenda Patterson, GM Parks, Forestry & Recreation announced today at the TSC Sports Summit Mr. Bhardwaj will be the Chair of the 2012 Ontario Summer Games.

Mr. Bhardwaj is the President & CEO of the Toronto Community Foundation, he was formerly a corporate lawyer with a leading Canadian law firm, Vice President of the Toronto 2008 Olympic Bid, and then CEO of United Way of York Region.

Rahul has a long history of community service, includes serving currently as a Board Member of the Stratford Festival of Canada, George Brown College, and Community Foundations of Canada, and previously, United Way Toronto and past Chair of the Toronto Downtown Jazz Festival, among others.

In 2007, Rahul was named by the National Post as one of the "Next Generation of Toronto Civic

Leaders." In 2008, Rahul was named as a member of Toronto Mayor David Miller's "Blue Ribbon" Fiscal Review Panel. Recently, the Province of Ontario appointed Rahul to the Board of Metrolinx.
