TSC Grant Application to true Sport a Success - Jane Finch Community

The TSC was successful with a grant application submitted to True Sport. The TSC was awarded \$15,000 to help increase the number of trained and certified youth sport leaders in the Jane Finch communities. As a result, the communities will have a greater capacity to provide high quality sport programming opportunities for school age children. True Sport is a social movement powered by people who believe that sport can transform lives and communities.
