TEAM Fund applications closing October 31st

The deadline for athletes to apply for a 2018 Toronto Emerging Athletes Mentorship (TEAM) Fund grant is October 31, 2017. The TEAM fund is a legacy from the 2012 Ontario Summer Games hosted in Toronto. The fund is aimed at providing financial assistance to eligible Toronto-based athletes. The athletes must be between the ages of 11 and 18 years old and demonstrate the ability to excel in their sport. Successful applicants are eligible to receive up to \$2,000 in financial assistance from the TEAM Fund. 16 athletes received funding in 2016 and 21 athletes received funding in 2017. 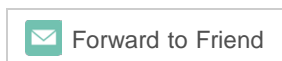
