The Toronto Sports Council was able to support six emerging athletes last year.

The TEAM Fund grant of up to \$2,000 is for Toronto youth between 11 and 18 years of

age who have demonstrated a pre-disposition to excel in a particular sport. The Fund is intended to help the athlete with the financial support they require to gain access to the 'next level' of training, equipment and competitions with a competitive club or league.
